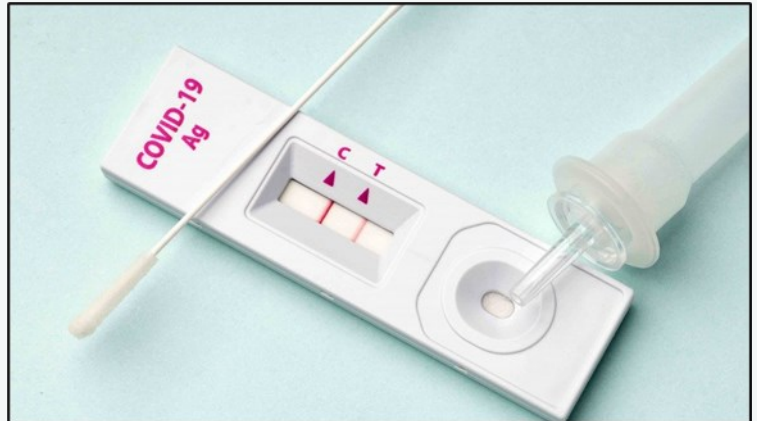
The NSW department of Education, currently, recommends children and staff wear face masks indoors, however this is a recommendation, it is **not** mandatory.

We also have face masks available for any family who would like some. Again, please contact the school.

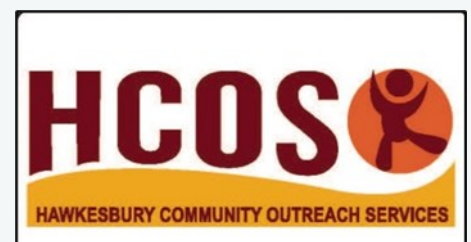


HAWKESBURY COMMUNITY OUTREACH SERVICES - SCIENCE FUN
